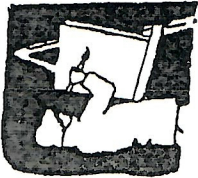

About Our Faculty

Laurie Harden- A graduate of Rhode Island School of Design, she specializes in Oil, Pastels & Drawing Fundamentals. An award winning artist, she has exhibited at the Salmagundi Club, the National Arts Club and Pen and Brush. Among her commissions are portraits of former NJ Governor, Brendan Byrne, and former Prime Minister of Japan, Keizo Obuchi.

Mark de Mos- An elected member of the New Jersey Watercolor Society as well as a signature member of the North East Watercolor Society in Kent, CT, the Garden State and Baltimore Water Societies. In addition, he has concentrated on pastel studies. His aim is to enable him to acquire a different perspective on the use and understanding of color, value, intensity and texture. He became the 1st President of the Pastel Society of NJ. Recipient of numerous awards and honors –nationally and locally.

Evan Stuart Marshall - Award-winning artist, Evan is best known for his whimsical, vividly colored mixed-media abstract paintings. His work has been featured in many juried exhibitions, both solo and group, and is held in many private collections around the world. Evan is active in several art Organizations including the Livingston Arts Association, Studio Montclair and the West Essex Art Association, on whose board he serves as membership chair.

Tim Maher - Primary medium is oil, but also enjoys working in watercolor and pastel. His interest is in figure and portraiture, usually in a realistic, contemporary environment. He considers himself a classical painter with an occasional impressionist leaning. The current president of the Art Centre of New Jersey (located at Riker Hill in Livingston). He graduated from Rider College (now University) with a B.A. in Fine Arts/ Studio and Design. Studied at the Art Students League in New York with Harvey Dinnerstein.

Barbara Sax - A award winning artist and teacher with over 40 years' experience. She has a BA and MA in education from Montclair State University, working in public schools in Roseland, Maplewood and Livingston and teaching privately in NJ and Florida. She has also taught art at Cranes Mill in West Caldwell. Barbara has assisted the YMCA to develop and implement diversity projects and classes for the disabled as well as working with the Livingston Youth and Community Services. She presently serves on the ACL Gallery board and is the current President of the Arts Council of Livingston.

Carol Lynn Nellen- A Certified Art Teacher for Grades k-12, has taught in the West Orange Public School System since 1970. She attended William Paterson University of NJ and the University of New Hampshire where she graduated with a B.S. in Art Education and also received her Teaching certification. She also earned graduate credits at Montclair State University, Kean University, Upsala College and Fairleigh Dickinson University.
